

1. Who Christ Is — “The Promised One”



In the Bible, the name **Christ** isn't Jesus' last name.

It means '**the One God promised**'—the Son of God.

All the way through the Old Testament, God promised Someone special who would save.

That Someone is Jesus.

Paul says Jesus is the '**Son of God**' (Romans 1:4, KJB).

He died for our sins, was buried in a tomb, rose alive again, and now lives forever.

When we say '**the Lord Jesus Christ**', we are saying:

- **Lord** - He is God.
- **Jesus** - He became a man to save us.
- **Christ** - He is the promised One."

2. Creation & the Fall — “Why We Need Jesus”

(Genesis 1-3, simplified)

God made a beautiful world. Everything was perfect. But one day, Adam and Eve, the first parents God created, did something God said not to do. That's called *sin*. Sin is when we don't do what God says.

And sin made the world sad and broken - that's why people get sick, hurt, or mean.

Sin is when we do things that hurt God. It's doing the bad or not doing the good.

But Jesus already paid for every sin because He loves you.


Truth:

That's why Jesus came. To fix what sin broke.

And He fixed it by dying for our sins, being buried in a tomb, and rising alive again.

Connection to the Gospel:

This is the Gospel: Jesus died for our sins, was buried, and rose again.




3. The Passover Lamb — “Jesus Took Our Place”

(Exodus 12, simplified)

Long ago, God told His people that a lamb had to die so they could be forgiven for their mistakes and sins. Without the shedding of blood there’s no forgiveness of sins.

The lamb didn’t do anything wrong, but it took their place. They had to do it year after year.



Truth:


Jesus is *our* Lamb. He took our place on the cross. He paid with His Blood for all your past, present, and future sins two thousand years ago! We're Reconciled with God!

Jesus loves you so much He took your place so you could be with Him forever by believing The Gospel, the Good News!

4. Paul's Salvation — “God Can Change Anyone”

(Acts 9, 13)

There was a man named Paul who didn't like Christians (Jesus Jewish Disciples) at all. One day, Jesus appeared to him and told him that he was chosen to tell the world the Mystery Message from God.



The Mystery is a secret God

didn't tell anyone before-

that people from every nation could be saved the same way and become one new family called the Body of Christ.

Paul believed Jesus, and Jesus changed him from the inside and made him our Messenger, our Apostle.

Truth:

When you believe the Gospel, God puts His Spirit inside you too forever and wants you to do what Paul wrote to us.

Walking in the Spirit:

Walking in the Spirit means letting Jesus help you make good choices every day. Walking in the Spirit means letting Jesus help your heart choose what is good.

It's like holding onto Jesus' hand in your thoughts.

Examples:

- Being kind when you don't feel like it
- Sharing
- Telling the truth
- Saying sorry
- Not giving up when frustrated

(painting, homework, etc.) Everything you do, think that you're doing it for Jesus and don't complain, but try to do your best.

Every time you choose what Jesus would want, you're walking in the Spirit!

5. The Armor of God

Ephesians 6:10-18 (KJB)

As soon as we **believe the Gospel**, God gives us a **special Armor**.

We need Armor because **God has an enemy**, and **Jesus disarmed him at the Cross**.


The Armor helps us **stand strong**, not be afraid, and remember **who we are in Christ**.

● **The Belt of Truth**

The **Word of God** is the **King James Bible (KJB)**.

The Belt holds the whole Armor together.

God's Word is **truth**.



The Shoes of Peace

The Shoes are **red** to remind us of **Jesus' blood**.

Jesus paid for the sins of **all the world**.

Because of Him, we have **peace with God** and with the world.

The Shield of Faith

Faith means **believing God**.

We are part of the **Body of Christ (BoC)** and are under **His care**.

The Shield helps protect us when hard thoughts come.

The Helmet of Salvation

Believing the **Gospel** saves you **forever**.

The Helmet protects our minds and reminds us:

“I belong to God.”

The Breastplate of Righteousness

God took **our sins** and put them on **Jesus**.

God took **Jesus' perfection** and put it on **us**.

That is called **righteousness** of God.

The Sword of the Spirit

This is our **only weapon**.

It is made of **verses from Scripture**.

We use God's Word to fight the enemy.

Resist the enemy and he shall **flee!**

6. Prayer

God wants us to talk to Him all the time, talking to God is called Prayer. The KJB shows us what God wants to hear:



“Dear Abba Father,
In the Name of Jesus,
By the Power of the Holy Ghost,

Thank You for...

I ask You for...”

7. The Body of Christ — “Jesus Special Team”

Imagine Jesus Christ chose a special team called **the Body of Christ (BoC)**. Every time someone believes the good news, the **Gospel—that Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose alive again the third day (1 Corinthians 15:1-4, KJB)**—Jesus places them on His team!

Some are good at helping, some at comforting, some at praying, some at teaching. But **Christ is the Head and** the source (Ephesians 1:22-23, KJB).

Just like your hands, feet, and eyes all work together, **every believer is important**. Nobody is extra. Nobody is useless.

And Jesus wants His BoC team to love each other, help each other, and grow together.”

8. Sealed & Adopted — “The King’s Unbreakable Stamp”

In Bible times, a king sealed a letter with hot wax and pressed his ring into it. **No one could break that seal.**

When you believe the Gospel, **God seals you with the Holy Spirit of promise** (Ephesians 1:13, KJB).

It’s like God presses His Royal Seal on you and says, ‘She’s Mine forever.’ You become the Temple of God living in you!



And then God does something even bigger—
He **adopts** you (Ephesians 1:5, KJB).

That means you become part of His forever family.

You don't earn it. You don't buy it.

You *belong* because God loves you.”

9. One Faith — “The Family with One Song”

Imagine a big family spread across towns and countries. They all look different and speak differently, but they share **one special song** that proves they're family.

Paul teaches that there is **‘one faith’** (Ephesians 4:5, KJB).

That means there is **one truth** for the Body of Christ today, one Gospel, one hope, one salvation.

So instead of fighting or acting alone, God wants us to be like a family singing one beautiful song together-

helping, teaching, comforting, praying, forgiving, and loving one another.

That's how the world sees Jesus in us.”

10. Right Division

1. When Did It Start?

Acts 13:2, 47– That’s when God sent **Paul** out and said,

“Separate Paul. This is the person I picked to send My message to the whole world.”

So Right Division starts when **God chose Paul for everyone** – not just Israel. God wants us to do what Paul did to **grow Jesus Team**.

2. What Makes God Happy?

2 Timothy 2:15 – God says,

“Study and divide the Bible the right way.”

That means:

Put each message in the right place, like sorting toys into the right box. Study, not just read the KJB which is His Word.

That makes God smile.

3. What Gets Divided?

Here are three big things

A. Two Different Groups

- **Israel** (Jews – earthly promises)
- **Everyone else** (Gentiles – heavenly promises)

God loves both, but He talks to them **in different ways** at different times.

B. Two Different Messages


- To Israel: **The King is coming to Earth.**
- Through Paul: **You go to Heaven by believing Jesus died for your sins, was buried, and rose again.**

(1 Corinthians 15:1-4 KJB)

They're both true, but they aren't the same message.

C. Two Different Destinations

- Israel gets a **Kingdom on Earth.**
- The Body of Christ gets a **Home in Heaven.**



God keeps His promises exactly the way He said He would.

4. Here's the "Core Sentence"

A one-breath summary you can *repeat back*:

"Right Division means we listen to what God said to Israel AND what God said to us, and we put each message in its right place."

Example

If a king writes a letter to his daughter and a letter to his friend, you don't mix the letters.

You read each letter the right way.

God did that too – one long set of letters for Israel, and special letters for us through Paul.


11. The Rapture – Harpazo (Our Blessed Hope!)

One day, Jesus will call all believers in His Body, the BoC, to meet Him in the clouds.

It will happen suddenly, like being gently lifted up fast – *Harpazo* means “caught up.”

This is God’s promise that we will always be with Him, safe and loved forever.

It’s a happy hope, not something to fear. (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)



12. The BEMA Seat of Rewards

2 Corinthians 5:10 (KJB)

1 Corinthians 3:11-15 (KJB)



After the **Rapture**, all believers – the **Body of Christ (BoC)** – will have a **celebration day** with Jesus.

This is called the **BEMA Seat**.

The BEMA Seat is **not** about punishment.

It is **not** about losing salvation.

Everyone at the BEMA is already **saved forever**.

The BEMA Seat is about **rewards**.

Jesus remembers the good things we did on earth
-
things done with **faith, love, and truth.**

At the BEMA Seat, the BoC will receive:



Prizes and Gifts from Jesus



Crowns from God the Father

Nothing done for Jesus is wasted.

Even small acts of love matter to Him.

The BEMA Seat reminds us that
what we do on earth for Jesus **counts**,
and one day, it will be **celebrated.**

13. The Revivalist Movement
